

## CORRECTION IS THE MOST WONDERFUL WORD IN THE COURSE

"Correction!"--it is the most wonderful word in this book. Why talk about correction if correction is impossible? Why talk about correction if correction isn't inevitable? You want that heart that's weak or irregular to embody singularity; perfect harmony of its function of identifying God and God's Purpose. And you want the evidence of it. And so you're going to dare to be miracle-minded enough to let it happen instead of arguing against it with your confidence that here is a place where God does not reign supreme--meaning your heart, or your mouth, or any other part of your body.
