MUSIC OF THE SPHERES

You will not have to wait until spring to enjoy the daffodils. This gives you some slight inkling of the fact that your experience of the world will be radically different. All negatives about it will be gone. Everything will manifest and express perfect harmony. And I will tell you this. You will not only feel the harmony, but you will experience the equivalent of hearing the harmony. Those who have allowed themselves to become very sensitive, who have not defended themselves totally, have referred to the music of the spheres. It is not a physical sound. You could say it is a spiritual sound. And every Divine Idea has a tone that you could say sings in harmony with every other tone.
